## SC Workers' Compensation Reference Sheet

### SCHEDULED LOSS - SECTION 42-9-30

**Thumb** = 65 weeks

**First (index) finger** = 40 weeks

**Second finger** = 35 weeks

**Third finger** = 25 weeks

**Fourth (little) finger** = 20 weeks

**First phalange thumb or any finger** = loss of  $\frac{1}{2}$  thumb or finger

**More than one phalange** = loss of entire thumb or finger (amount received for > 1 finger shall not exceed value of entire hand)

**Great toe** = 35 weeks

**Toe (other than great)** = 10 weeks

**First phalange any toe** = loss of one half of the toe

**More than one phalange** = loss of entire toe

**Hand** = 185 weeks

**Arm** = 220 weeks

**Shoulder** = 300 weeks (D/A on or after 7/1/07)

**Foot** = 140 weeks

**Leg** = 195 weeks

**Hip** = 280 weeks (D/A on or after 7/1/07)

**Eye** = 140 weeks (see R.67-1105 loss of vision)

**Loss of hearing one ear** = 80 weeks (see R.67-1102)

**Loss of hearing both ears** = 165 weeks (see R.67-1102)

**Back 49% or less** = 300 weeks

**Back 50% or more** = presumed permanently & totally disabled; however, for D/A on/after 7/1/07 presumption is rebuttable, in which case PPD based upon 500 weeks

**Serious permanent disfigurement of face, head, neck, or other area**

**normally exposed in employment** = 50 weeks (no disfigurement payable in addition to scheduled member loss unless serious burn scar or keloid scar)

**Breast** = 75 weeks (10-75 weeks partial loss)  
**Breasts** = 250 weeks (25-250 weeks partial loss)  
**Coccyx** = 10 weeks (1-10 weeks partial loss)  
**Gall Bladder** = 75 weeks (10-75 weeks partial loss)  
**Kidney** = 400 weeks (25-250 weeks partial loss)  
**Lung** = 400 weeks (25-250 weeks partial loss)  
**Pancreas** = 500 weeks (10-250 weeks partial loss)  
**Penis** = 350 weeks (25-250 weeks partial loss)  
**Rib** = 10 weeks (1.5-10 weeks partial loss)  
 (4 Ribs = max 200)  
**Scrotum and Testicles** = 350 weeks  
 (30-300 weeks partial loss)  
**Testicle** = 75 weeks (10-75 weeks partial loss)  
**Testicles** = 250 weeks (25-250 weeks partial loss)  
**Spleen** = 25 weeks (2.5-25 weeks partial loss)  
**Tongue** = 500 weeks (50-500 weeks partial loss)  
**Tooth** = 2 weeks (0.5-2 weeks partial loss)  
**Biliary Tract** = 75-400 weeks  
**Bladder** = 25-250 weeks  
**Brain** = 25-250 weeks

**Bronchi or Bronchus** = 25-400 weeks  
**Esophagus** = 25-400 weeks  
**Cervix** = 10-100 weeks
